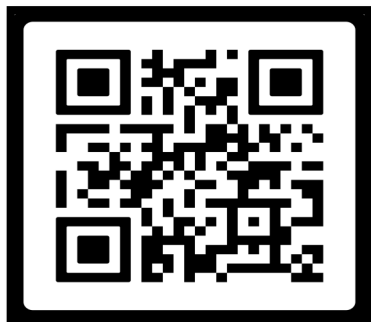
The Residential Experience
