# **Frequently Asked Questions**

## When and where is the Spring 2024 Career & Internship Fair?

### Where will the fair be held?

### What is the cost to participate?

The registration fee is \$450.00 for non-profit organizations and \$800.00 for all other businesses. Each additional representative (two are included with the registration) costs an additional \$75.00. Full payments should be made by February 2, 2024.

## Refunds/ No Shows/ Late Payments/ Day-Of Registrants:

Refunds requested on or before December 31, 2023 will result in a full refund.

Refunds requested *between December 31, 2023 and January 8, 2024* will result in being charged 50% of the registration fee.

Refunds requested after January 8, 2024 will be denied. This includes "No Shows".

Additional fees will be remitted for late registrants.

### What payment methods are accepted?

All major credit cards are accepted (AMEX, Discover, MasterCard, and Visa). A credit card payment may be made at the time of registration (online) or called in to the Career Center office.
