Dear Graduating Students,

To ensure a smooth, safe, and respectful Commencement ceremony, the following procedures have been established for all guests. It is critical that each graduate communicates these guidelines to their attendees in advance.

TICKET REQUIREMENTS

- All guests must present a valid ticket for entry.
- No ticket, no entry—no exceptions.
- Tickets will be verified for authenticity. Each valid ticket has a "DO NOT DUPLICATE" sticker placed over the Hampton University seal on the back.
- Once checked, tickets will be collected and cannot be returned to the guest.

RE-ENTRY POLICY

- Guests who exit the venue must visit the ticket booth to obtain a re-entry armband.
- Re-entry is allowed only through Doors A or C.
- Armbands must be surrendered upon re-entry.

VENUE CAPACITY & OVERFLOW

- Once the Convocation Center reaches full capacity, additional guests will be directed to:
 - Outdoor seating areas near the Convocation Center fountain, or
 - o The **Student Center**, where the ceremony will be **live-streamed at both locations**.

SEATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Guests may only sit in the building for which their ticket was issued.
- No one is allowed on the floor level unless they require handicapped seating accommodations, in which case one attendant may accompany them.
- Ushers will assist those needing accessible seating.
- Saving seats or blocking off rows is strictly prohibited.

3 ACCESSIBLE PARKING & WHEELCHAIR INFO

- Handicapped parking is available in Lot 11 at the Convocation Center.
- Wheelchairs are NOT provided by the University. Guests needing a wheelchair should arrange rentals in advance through a local pharmacy.
