Academic Heraldry

The *History* of academic dress reaches far back into the early days of the oldest universities. A statute of 1321 in England required that all “Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors” of the University of Coimbra wear gowns. Gowns may have been counted necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars. Hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until superseded for that purpose by the skull cap. However, representatives of various American colleges and universities adopted a system of academic apparel following a conference at Columbia University in 1895. In 1902 the Regents of the State of New York gave a charter to an organization named the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume to serve as a source of information and guidance in such matters. In 1932 the American Council on Education authorized the appointment of a committee to approve a code for academic costumes that has been in effect since that year.

Gowns to be used in the colleges and universities have the following characteristics. The gown for the bachelor’s degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master’s degree has an oblong sleeve and is open at the wrist. The sleeve base hangs down in the traditional manner. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut, and the front part has an arc cut away. The gown is so designed and supplied with fasteners that it may be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor’s degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is so designed and supplied with fasteners that it may be worn open or closed.

There are no trimmings for the bachelor’s or master’s degrees. For the doctor’s degree, the gown to be faced down the front with black velvet with three bars of the same across the sleeves; or these facings and crossbars may be of velvet of the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains.

For all academic purposes, the colors associated with the different subjects include some of the following:

Honorary Degrees

Honorary degrees are awarded by colleges and universities in recognition of scholarly or creative attainments or distinguished public service. Since 1860 most honorary degrees have taken the form of doctorates. Presidents, governors and leaders of the judiciary are often honored as well as educators, clergymen and university trustees. Recognition is also accorded authors, artists and leaders in mass communication. Honorary doctorates usually awarded are: doctor of laws, doctor of humane letters, doctor of divinity, doctor of science, doctor of literature, doctor of letters, and doctor of *Music*.

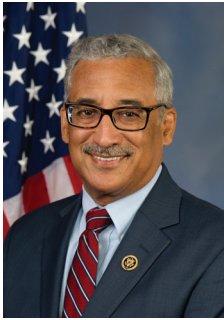
The 2026 Class Covenant

The Commencement Speaker

CONGRESSMAN ROBERT C. “BOBBY” SCOTT

*Third Congressional District of Virginia
Ranking Member, Committee on Education and the Workforce*



Congressman Robert C. “Bobby” Scott has represented Virginia’s third congressional district in the U.S. House of Representatives since 1993. Prior to his service in Congress, he served in the Virginia House of Delegates from 1978 to 1983 and in the Senate of Virginia from 1983 to 1993.

During his tenure in the Virginia General Assembly, Congressman Scott successfully sponsored laws critical to Virginians in education, employment, health care, social services, economic development, crime prevention and consumer protection. His legislative successes in the General Assembly included laws that increased Virginia’s minimum wage, created the Governor’s Employment and Training Council and improved health care benefits for women, infants and children.

His 1992 election to Congress gave Congressman Scott the distinction of being the first African-American elected to Congress from Virginia since John Mercer Langston’s election more than 100 years earlier during the Reconstruction era. Having a maternal grandfather of Filipino ancestry also gives him the distinction of being the first American with Filipino ancestry to serve as a voting member of Congress.

In the 118th Congress, Congressman Scott serves as the Ranking Member of the Committee on Education and the Workforce—his fifth term as the Committee’s Democratic leader. Throughout his tenure, he has advanced legislation that improves equity in education, frees students from the burdens of debt, protects and expands access to affordable health care, ensures workers have a safe workplace where they can earn a living wage free from discrimination, and guarantees seniors have a secure and dignified retirement.

During the 116th and 117th Congresses (2019-2023), Congressman Scott served as Chairman of what was then called the Committee on Education and Labor. As Chairman, Congressman Scott spearheaded critical parts of Congress’ response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Through several COVID-19 packages—including the American Rescue Plan Act—Congressman Scott’s efforts saved the pensions of over one million workers and retirees; reduced the number of uninsured Americans to record lows; significantly reduced child hunger across the nation; and delivered the single largest investment to K-12 schools in U.S. History to help schools reopen safely and make up for lost learning time. Notably, Congressman Scott has championed several other landmark bills in the House of Representatives—including the Every Student Succeeds Act, the Raise the Wage Act, the Protecting the Right to Organize Act, the Equity Inclusion and Enforcement Act, and the Juvenile Justice Reform Act of 2017, which included key components of Congressman Scott’s Youth PROMISE Act. Congressman Scott has also served on the Committee on the Budget and the Committee on the Judiciary, and he remains a leading voice in Congress on fiscal policy, the Constitution and reforming our nation’s *Criminal Justice* system.

During his tenure as Chairman and Ranking Member of the Committee on the Judiciary’s Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism and Homeland Security, Congressman Scott authored several bills to improve and reform our nation’s *Criminal Justice* system. He sponsored the Death in Custody Reporting Act, which enhances transparency and accountability for law enforcement by requiring state and local law enforcement agencies to report to the U.S. Department of Justice data on how many individuals die annually in custody or during arrest. In 2010, Congressman Scott successfully led efforts in the House to pass the Fair Sentencing Act, one of the first successful reductions in a federal mandatory minimum sentence in decades that reduced the unfair sentencing disparity between crack and powder cocaine. In 2015, he worked across the aisle to sponsor the Safe, Accountable, Fair, and Effective (SAFE) Justice Act, of which several important provisions were included in the bipartisan First Step Act signed into law by President Trump in 2018.

Congressman Scott was born on April 30, 1947 in Washington, D.C. and grew up in Newport News, Virginia. He is a graduate of Harvard College and Boston College Law School. After graduating from law school, he returned home to Newport News and practiced law from 1973 to 1991. As a young attorney, he founded the Peninsula Legal Aid Center to assist those who could not afford legal representation, and served as one of the youngest branch presidents of the Newport News NAACP. He received an honorable discharge for his service in the Massachusetts National Guard and the United States Army Reserve.

Congressman Scott is a member of St. Augustine’s Episcopal Church in Newport News and is a member of many professional, community, and civic organizations.

Mr. Leon Chisolm is the CEO and founder of Chisolm Communities, LLC. Chisolm Communities develops single family and build 10 rent residential subdivisions in the Carolinas.

Prior to founding Chisolm Communities, Mr. Chisolm served as the Eastern North Carolina Market Executive for JPMorgan Chase, leading the firm's commercial banking, community engagement, and philanthropic efforts in the Raleigh, Greensboro, and Coastal Carolina regions.

Mr. Chisolm is also the founder of Chisolm Foundation, the philanthropic arm of Chisolm Communities. Chisolm Foundation focuses on providing college scholarships to high achieving students and supporting organizations that provide educational support and skill development to high school and college students. During his time as a corporate executive, Mr. Chisolm personally sponsored scholarships to organizations such as the Charlotte and Raleigh Hampton Alumni Chapters, Young Black Leaders of America (YBLA) and the 100 Black Men amongst others.

He serves on the board of Communities in School of North Carolina and is the Vice Chairman of the District 4 Neighborhood Coalition, an advocacy group that works with the Charlotte City Council, HOAs, and city staff to promote responsible development and improve the quality of life for the residents in the community.

Lastly, Mr. Chisolm was previously selected as a 40 under 40 Recipient by the Triangle Business Journal and recognized on the 2025 Most Influential List by Who's Who in Black Charlotte.

Mr. Chisolm earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration and MBA from Hampton University.

MR. MICHAEL A. BYRD '80

Mr. Michael A. Byrd was born in Assawoman, Virginia on Virginia's Eastern Shore. He graduated from Hampton Institute in 1980 receiving a Bachelor of Science in Accounting and was commissioned into the U.S. Army Ordnance Corps. Mr. Byrd also holds a Master of Business Administration (Comptrollership) from Syracuse University and Master of Arts degree in Business Management from Central Michigan University. His military education includes completion of the Command and General Staff College, Ordnance Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, the Army Comptroller Course and Professional Military Comptroller Course.

Mr. Byrd successfully completed over 24 years of Active Duty with the United States Army, retiring at the grade of Lieutenant Colonel. His culminating military assignment was the Command Budget Officer, 3rd US Army, Fort McPherson, GA. After retiring from the US Army, he became the Comptroller of the Southeast Region (SER) of the National Park Service (NPS). Mr. Byrd retired from the NPS in June 2021. He was named the 2016 SER Employee of the Year after leading his team which was named the entire NPS's Organization of the Year by the Director of the National Park Service.

Civically, Mr. Byrd is a Life Member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated and was initiated through the Gamma Iota Chapter, Hampton University. He is a member of the Pi Gamma Lambda Chapter currently and serves as the Committee Chair for the Go to High School, Go to College (GTHSGTC) National Program in Clayton County, Georgia. He was also the Co-Chair of Alumni Giving for the National Hampton Alumni Association (NHAA) from 2014-2018, serving with his good friend and classmate, Andre Debose, culminating in 2018 when the alumni and philanthropic entities raised over \$2.8M during his last year in that role, supporting his alma mater, Hampton University. Over his tenure as the Co-Chair, Hampton University's donor rate soared from 13% to 28%, which in the world of philanthropic giving is no small feat. During the four years as one of the Co-Chairs for Alumni Giving, each year the alumni averaged over \$2M annually in donations to support the school, faculty, infrastructure and students. During the Class of 1980's five-year span from 2020 to 2025 he and Bert insured the class made each fundraising goal established by Hampton University. Additionally, -Mr. Bryd regularly supports the food ministry at Andrews Chapel UMC where bi-monthly the church supports over 120 families. In his spare time, he officiates college and high school basketball games and volleyball in Georgia and Alabama and has been officiating basketball for over 39 years. Mr. Byrd gives credit for his civic and community outreach to his mother, who he saw give back to her local community daily. He truly believes in Letting His Life Do the Singing.

Mr. Byrd is married to the former Gina Renee Johnson and is the proud father of Markita Ann Bivens Walker and M. Carson Arrington Byrd (Hampton University, '11).

Historical Sketch

When the Hampton Normal and Agricultural Institute opened its doors in April 1868, in the days of Reconstruction, listed as assets were two teachers, fifteen students, little money or equipment, and the faith in its principle of “learning by doing” and “Education for Life.”

The principal was Samuel Chapman Armstrong, a 29-year-old Brevet Brigadier General, son of missionary parents. He had been assigned by the Freedmen’s Bureau to help solve the problems of the thousands of former slaves who had gathered behind Union lines on the Virginia peninsula. He founded, with the aid of the American Missionary Association, a school at Hampton to train selected young men and women “who should go out and teach and lead their people, first by example, and in his way to build up an industrial system for the sake not only of self-support and intelligent labor, but also for the sake of character.”

Hampton may well be thankful that in the concept of “Education for Life” – including efficiency, character, and usefulness to society – General Armstrong established a standard, timeless in its appeal and application. Hampton today finds this concept highly adaptable to the changing conditions of life in this century and the likely challenges of the twenty-first century.

The first conditions for admission were simple: “Sound health, good character, age not less than fourteen years and not more than twenty-five, ability to read and write intelligibly, knowledge of arithmetic through long division, intention to remain throughout the whole course of three years and to become a teacher.”

Support in the early days came from philanthropic and religious groups and individuals, from Federal Land-Grant Funds (1872-1920), and numerous other sources. With the help of the Freedmen’s Bureau and northern philanthropists, the school was able to erect a classroom building – the Academy, since rebuilt – in 1871. Residence Quarters, however, continued to be a problem, with the men living in army tents for three years and the women living in barracks until the completion of Virginia Hall. Some of the money for this building was raised by the Hampton Singers, who toured northern communities.

In 1878, a group of Indians was sent to Hampton to be educated with the help of federal funds. These appropriations were continued until 1912. The Indians continued to attend Hampton until 1923, when Indian schools became more numerous and were equipped well enough for Hampton to discontinue its successful contribution to Indian education.

After his death in 1893, General Armstrong’s work was continued and expanded for nearly a quarter-century under the leadership of the late Reverend Hollis B. Frissell. Courses leading to the bachelor’s degree were first offered in 1922. Courses at the elementary and secondary level were dropped gradually, and all resources of the institution were applied to education at the college level. Accreditation as a Class “A” College was achieved during the 1932-33 academic year.

In line with its broadening educational program, the college inaugurated graduate courses in 1928. Course work leading to the Master of Arts degree in education was offered during summer school sessions only. Although discontinued in 1949, graduate study was reactivated in 1956, and for the first time was offered during the regular year as well as during summer school. A Division of Graduate Studies was organized in 1956 as the administrative unit to replace the former Division of Summer Extension Study. Then, in October 1967, following a visitation by representatives of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, a new all-institution faculty committee, the Graduate Council, was organized. The Graduate College was established in 1984. In 1992, the first doctoral degree was approved – the Doctor of Philosophy degree in *Physics*. The University now offers four doctoral degrees in *Physics*, pharmacy, *Physical Therapy*, and *Nursing*.

From humble origins, Hampton University has evolved into a prestigious, nationally acclaimed university that sets *The Standard of Excellence* in education.
