Your 2026–2027 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review for a process called verification. To verify that you provided correct information we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. **You and a parent whose information was reported on the FAFSA must complete and sign this worksheet**, attach any required documents, and submit the form with any other required documents to the financial aid office. Please note that we may ask for additional documentation if we have reason to believe that the information provided is inaccurate. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

B. Identity/Statement of Educational Purpose – At the Institution

The student must appear in person at Hampton University to verify his or her identity by presenting a valid government-issued photo identification (ID) that is acknowledged in the notary statement below, such as but not limited to a driver’s license, other state-issued ID, or passport. The institution will maintain a copy of the student’s photo ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student’s ID.
