Contracting Eligibility Requirements

- Be classified as a full time graduate student at Hampton University
- Be between the ages of 17-31 years old
- Be a US Citizen or Resident
- Be able to pass a criminal background check
- Be single or married, but with less than 3 dependents
- Be Medically cleared for service (DoDMERB Physical)
- Have at least a 2.5 for scholarship
- Be on track to graduate w/ your class
- Pass the Army Fitness Assessment
- Meet the Army Height and Weight Standards

- \$1200.00 a year for books
- Monthly Stipend for living expenses

GRFD Scholarship

• Exclusively for US Army Reserves or the VA National Guard soldiers

 Nomination/Application process completed by component enlisted recruiter, the soldier and ROTC personnel.

GRFD Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- Currently in USAR/ARNG or eligible to enlist
- U.S. Citizen
- Between the ages of 17-31 (Cannot turn 31 by DEC 31st of Commissioning year)
- Valid MEPS Chapter 2 physical for enlistment
- DoDMERB physical for ROTC
 "scheduled" for scholarship offer and
 completed DoDMERB to contract
 with ROTC
- Pass a physical fitness assessment to contract
- Be in compliance with AR 600-9 Body Composition standards

- 2.5 CGPA
- Once contracted maintain 2.0 College GPA
- Participate in Simultaneous
 Membership Program (SMP)
- Once commissioned, 8-year service obligation actively drilling at a Unit

GRFD Scholarship Benefits

A contracted GRFD scholarship Cadet can earn:

- Full Tuition/Fees or Room/Board (\$12K per year)
- \$1200 a year book stipend
- ROTC Cadet stipend each month \$420
- Earn E-5 drill pay ~ \$350
