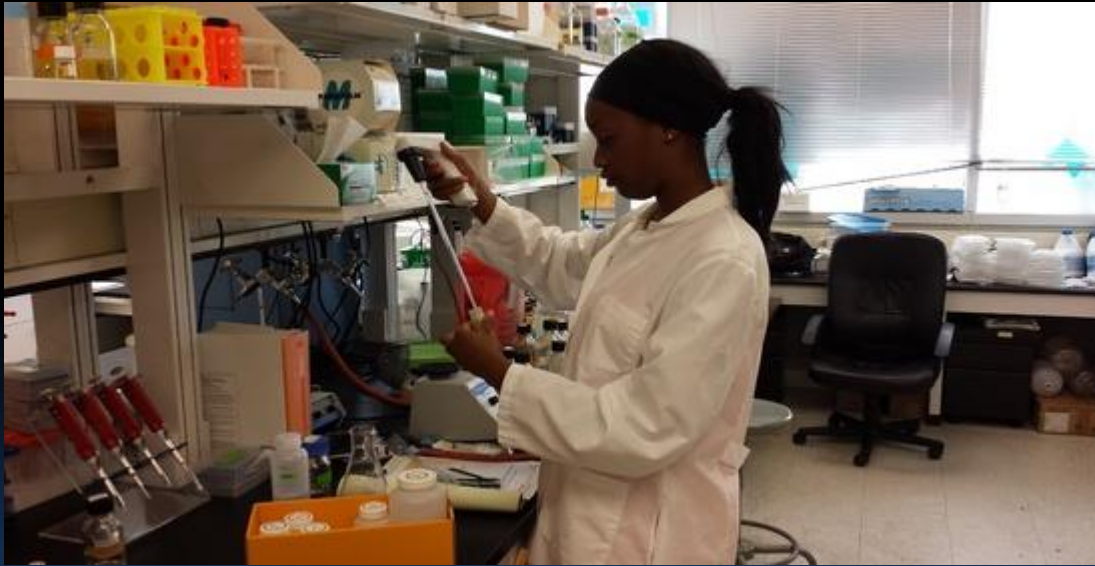

Hampton University is the first and only HBCU to have had 100% control of a NASA mission.

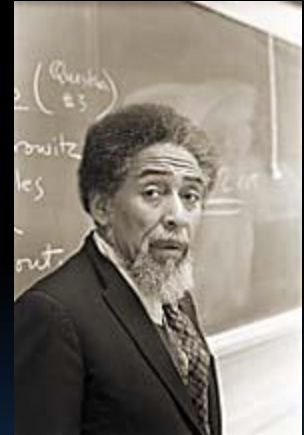
