### MAIN CAMPUS GRADUATE TUITION AND FEES 2025-2026

- Less than 10 credit hours: 721/per credit hour
- ► 10-17 credit hours, per semester: \$14,154
- ► In excess of 17 credit hours: \$478/ per credit hour

#### **Application Process**

Applications may be acquired from the Financial Aid Office. Completed applications must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office of the institution on, or before, September 15 prior to the fall semester of enrollment. Applications submitted after September 15, but no later than December 1, will be considered for an award only if funds are available.

#### Possible Graduate Assistantships

Each year, HU offers approximately 55 Graduate Assistantships (GAs) to graduate students. Typically, these offer tuition remission of up to 80% of the first 9 credit hours and a small monthly stipend. These include:
