Early Admission Entering Fall 2026

(applications accepted on a rolling basis until July 1<sup>st</sup>)

**April 15, 2026**

Entering Summer 2026

**May 1, 2026**

Communicative Sciences and Disorders Fall 2026

**July 1, 2026 Admission Deadline**

(applications accepted on a case-by-case basis through August)

# International Application Materials & Supplemental Documents

## Supplemental Documents

- An official transcript from each college/university attended with English translation.
- Please request official translations services (ex. WES Worldwide Evaluation Services).
- A credential evaluation is a comparison of your academic accomplishments to the standards in the United States.
- Copy of Passport/VISA
- Official test scores:
  - MCAT or DAT (Medical Science applicants)
  - GRE IS WAIVED INDEFINITELY FOR ALL MAIN CAMPUS APPLICANTS
  - GMAT – MBA 5YR Program – program offered to continuing undergraduate Business students only
- Resume (Counseling and Sport Leadership Certificate applicants only)
- In addition to the above test scores:
  - Duolingo, TOEFL or IELTS (applicants whose native language is not English)
- Two letters of recommendation (must be on official letterhead; signature is required)
- Three letters of recommendations required for Marine and Environmental Science and Atmospheric and Planetary Science applicants
- Personal Statement
