Hampton University requires all full-time undergraduate students will be automatically enrolled in and billed **\$1,101.00** for the Annual coverage period of the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) unless a waiver is submitted and approved by the waiver deadline. All students **must** submit a form electing to either enroll in or waive out of the Annual Student Health Insurance Plan.

What changes have been made to the Plan for the 2023-2024 Policy Year?

- All waivers will be audited to confirm they are acceptable in the Hampton University service area.
- ID cards will only be available at www.anthem.com or download the [Sydney Health mobile app](#).

To complete the Waiver or Enrollment form:

1. Go to www.gallagherstudent.com/Hamptonu.
2. Under 'Profile', enter your Hampton University email address and click on LOG IN.
3. **First Time Users:** You will need to complete the registration form by clicking on SIGN UP.
4. Click on the 'WAIVE' or 'ENROLL' button under 'Plan Summary'.
5. Follow the instructions to complete the form.
6. Save a copy of your reference number.
7. Review the information entered for accuracy and click 'submit' to complete the process. Immediately upon submitting your Online Form you will receive a reference number. Please note and keep this information for your record.

Please take note of the deadline. Forms submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
