Duties and Responsibilities

- Provides outpatient primary care services for episodic illnesses, health maintenance and wellness screenings
- Follows appropriate care/treatment plans as ordered by the provider
- Consistently develops effective care/treatment plan for assigned patients according to established protocols and procedures
- Documents patient's medical information and maintains electronic medical records
- Schedules consultation or referral appointments with other health care providers
- Dispenses medications as ordered by the provider
- Provides information to provider regarding patient's care plan and condition
- Regularly confers and consults with appropriate supervisor as indicated
- Educates, instructs, and counsels patients on presenting health problems, treatment plans, and home care, and
 encourages and promotes preventative health care and positive health behaviors as instructed by the provider

Requirements

- Excellent interpersonal and organizational skills
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Must be compassionate and personable with an interest in college health
- Ability to communicate effectively with patients and other medical staff
- Must possess skills, self-confidence, and ability to remain calm in stressful situations
- Ability to triage mental health issues and work closely with colleagues in the Student Counseling Center
- · Ability to multitask, triage health problems, and respond effectively to medical emergencies
- Excellent analytical and critical thinking skills
- Exceptional active listening skills
- Data entry skills a must
- Must work on call after-hours and weekends as scheduled

- Must have Practical Nursing Diploma from an accredited nursing school
- Must have a current license to practice as an LPN in the Commonwealth of Virginia
- Must have the necessary certification
- 2-4 years of clinical work experience
