Hampton University is one of the nine schools on the fifteenth University Affiliated Research Center (UARC) funded by the Department of Defense and the first one for a HBCU consortium. The prestigious award is a \$90 M contract awarded by the Air Force for a period of five years. It will be led by Howard University and will fund research in the area of tactical autonomy. The Hampton University team is led by Dr. Joyce Shirazi, Dean for the School of Engineering, Architecture and Aviation (SEAA). The inaugural meeting for the consortium members was held at Howard University on May 15-16, 2023. It was attended by SEAA faculty and staff members from Human Resources, Business and Vice President for Research (VPR) offices. Dr. Neelam Azad, Vice President for Research, who was in attendance, expressed that it is a tremendous accomplishment by the consortium members and Hampton University is leading the pack in research with unique capabilities and expertise of faculty in SEAA and Department of Atmospheric and Planetary Sciences in the School of Science.

### **RESEARCH GRANTS**



Dr. Aresta Johnson, Dean, University College, received \$ 2.2 M award from the Department of Education (DoEd) to support development and opera-

tion of the Workforce Development program. Dr. Johnson also serves as the PI for the IT modernization certification pilot program funded by DoEd.

The funding will provide support for a post doctoral researcher in the Severe Weather Research Laboratory and will aid in continuing research to improve short-term weather forecasts.
