

Prehealth requirements

Prehealth requirements vary widely, but many schools require the following science courses: Introductory biology with lab (BIO 103 or 105- 106) Inorganic (general) chemistry with lab (CHE 201 -202) Organic chemistry with lab (CHE 301), Physics with lab (two-semester sequence), English (two semesters), Mathematics (statistics, one semester), Social sciences (psychology, sociology, two semesters), Biochemistry (CHE 303), Advanced biology (one semester).

You can major in any program as long as you complete the required classes for the institutions you plan to attend, demonstrate academic excellence, intellectual curiosity, and meet the competencies for admission. Meet with the HU-UPP director or an HU-UPP advisor for more information

Eastern Virginia Medical School, Norfolk, VA

Sophomores may apply by Nov 15; GPA 3.5+, 25 hours of volunteer or service, 50+ hours of clinical exposure required. https://www.evms.edu/

Meharry Medical College School of Medicine, Nashville, TN

Selected HU studentsmay apply; 3.25 SCI GPA; 900 SAT/20 ACT. Spend up to three (3) summers at Meharry Medical College School of Medicine. https://home.mmc.edu/

Upstate Medical University, Norton College of Medicine, NY

High school seniorsand selected students and alumni may apply. Spend three (3) summers at SUNY Upstate MedicalUniversityUpstate Scholars Program. Must maintain a minimum 3.5 overall and SCIGPA http://www.upstate.edu/com/

Penn State University College of Medicine, Hershey, PA Juniorsmay apply to the PA Early AssuranceProgram:GRE scaled score of 311 (quant. & verbal) analytical writing score of 4.0; maintain a minimum 3.5 overall and SCI GPA. https://med.psu.edu/

American University of Antigua, College of Medicine,

Antigua All HU students are eligible to apply for Guaranteed Admission with 3.0 GPA. Application fee waived for 5 HU students per year. Expedited admissions timeline, grant, and scholarship applications available for 3.25 GPA. https://www.auamed.org

Salus University College of Optometry,

Philadelphia, PA Freshmen may apply. Complete Pre-Optometry curriculum at HU, 25+hours shadowing. Score 300+ on each section of OAT, Maintain a 3.0+ overall GPA

Virginia Commonwealth University School of Medicine, Richmond, VA

Sophomores are eligible to apply; 3.5 GPA; Honors College. Spend two (2) summers at VCU other requirements apply. https://medschool.vcu.edu/

University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine, Philadelphia, PA

High school seniors may apply. Spend three (3) summers and senior year at the School of Dental Medicine. International students are eligible. https://med.psu.edu/physician-assistant/apply

Ross University School of Medicine, MD

Pathway residency in the USA. All HU students and alums are eligible to apply as long as they earned a degree within 5 years of applying to RUSM. Multiple scholarships are available. Residency is on the US the mainland.
