1 Submit an Inquiry

Start by completing the Hampton University Advocacy Inquiry Form, available on our website. This form allows you to share your interests and how you'd like to help.

2 Define Your Advocacy Interests

On the form, select the areas where you're interested in advocating, such as your:

- Social and Fraternal Organizations
- Church and Faith Communities
- Network of Policymakers
- Conventions and Conferences
- Personal Network

3 Provide Details on Your Influence

Describe specific organizations, churches, or communities where you have an influence. If applicable, mention any legislators or policymakers you have connections with.

4 Indicate Support Needed

Let the Office of Advancement know what information or support would be most helpful for your advocacy efforts, such as talking points, fact sheets, or guidance on contacting officials.

5 Collaborate with Advancement

A representative from the Office of Advancement will review your submission and contact you to discuss ways you can collaborate to amplify Hampton's voice.
