#### **Application Requirements**

This is for your information. Do not submit with your application packet. Read the requirements carefully to make sure you meet the minimum eligibility for the Professional Nursing program and have submitted all of your documents. Meeting the minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee admission to the professional program. A Scholarship, Standards and Admissions Committee (SSA) utilizes a competitive ranking scale to make the final decision.

#### Professional Nursing Program minimum eligibility requirements:

- Must have been admitted to the Pre-Professional Nursing Program at Hampton University.
- Successful completion of all Pre-Professional Nursing Courses (see Prerequisites on page 4).
- Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Cumulative science and math grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Not more than one repeat in required math or science courses to achieve a passing grade of "C".
- Not more than one repeat in nursing courses to achieve a passing grade of "78".
- Not more than one course withdrawal in math and/or science courses to achieve a passing grade of "C".
- Math and science prerequisites may be no more than 5 years old at time of the application deadline.
- Acceptable scores on the TEAS® exam

TEAS® scores (dated not more than one year prior to application).

Video Interview In lieu of Recommendations and the Essay, record a YouTube video of yourself answering the following questions:

- Why do you want to be a Bachelors prepared Registered nurse?
- What are your goals relative to nursing?
- Why do nursing programs and healthcare organizations have policies?
- Choose a Hampton University School of Nursing policy and state why it is important?

All items must be submitted together as one package and uploaded to the Hampton University School of Nursing Blackboard Community tab, Professional Program Application. Include the YouTube video link on <u>page</u> 8 of the application.

Applicant must be in **Professional Attire** when recording video responses. Videos should not exceed **10 minutes** in length.
