

# FACT SHEET TRIO UPWARD BOUND PROGRAM HAMPTON UNIVERSITY

The Upward Bound Program was initiated at Hampton University in the 1960s. The program is designed to aid participants in transitioning and completing a post-secondary program of study after graduating high school. The participants must be enrolled in Newport News Public Schools in either Denbigh, Warwick, Heritage, or Achievable Dream high schools. The participants must have a demonstrated academic and financial need and exemplify potentials for success in education beyond high school.

While in Upward Bound participants will be offered:

- Academic tutoring
- Advice and assistance in postsecondary course selection
- Preparation for successful completion of college entrance exams
- Information on federal Pell grant awards, loan forgiveness, and scholarships
- Assistance completing applications for federal student aid, as well as guidance with secondary school reentry
- Exposure to college tours and cultural enrichment activities, and more

In addition to these services, Upward Bound staff will develop a six-week non-residential Summer Enrichment Academy for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders with an emphasis on increasing student achievement. Freshmen and sophomores will be provided instruction in Math, Science, English, and World Language with course content based on State Assessments and PSAT objectives. Juniors and seniors will receive instruction in those same subjects with course content based on state assessments, SAT, ACT, or other college entrance exams. *The completion of one full Summer Enrichment Academy during participation in the program is required.* 

**ELIGIBILITY:** In order to qualify for **tentative** acceptance to the Hampton University Upward Bound Program, the student must:

- Meet the income eligibility criterion established by current Federal Guidelines
- Be a potential first-generation college bound student (neither of whose parent (s) received a baccalaureate degree)
- Be a citizen or national of the United States
- Be at least 13 years old (and no more than 19 years old) and a rising 9<sup>th</sup> grader at the time of acceptance
- Have a need for academic support in order to successfully pursue a program of study in education beyond high school.



#### **APPLICATION CHECKLIST**

Evidence of family income (1040 or 1040A Tax Form; W-2 forms not acceptable)

- Student's Social Security Number included on Application
- Recommendation for the program by an adult other than a relative. (Preferably the guidance counselor OR Mathematics or Science teacher at the school the student is attending.)
- Student's most recent high school transcript
