

FACT SHEET TRIO UPWARD BOUND PROGRAM HAMPTON UNIVERSITY

The Upward Bound Program, at Hampton University has served high school students since the 1960's. The program is designed to aid participants in transitioning and completing a post-secondary program of study after graduating high school. The participants must be enrolled in Newport News Public Schools in one of the following schools: Denbigh, Warwick, Heritage, or Achievable Dream High School. The participants must have a demonstrated academic and financial need and exemplify potentials for success in education beyond high school.

While in Upward Bound participants will be offered:

- Academic tutoring
- Advice and assistance in postsecondary course selection
- Preparation for successful completion of college entrance exams
- Information on federal Pell grant awards, loan forgiveness, and scholarships
- Assistance completing applications for federal student aid, as well as guidance with secondary school reentry
- Exposure to college tours and cultural enrichment activities, and more

In addition to these services, Upward Bound staff offers a six-week non-residential Summer Enrichment Academy for rising 9th-12th graders with an emphasis on increasing student achievement; and a non-credit Summer Bridge Program for our graduates with an emphasis on transitioning to college.

ELIGIBILITY: In order to qualify for initial acceptance to Hampton University's Upward Bound Program, the student must:

- Meet the income eligibility criterion established by Federal Guidelines
- Be a potential first-generation college bound student (neither of whose parent (s) received a baccalaureate degree)
- Be a citizen or national of the United States
- Be at least 13 years old (and no more than 19 years old) and a rising 9th through 12th grader at the time of acceptance
- have a need for academic support in order to successfully pursue a program of study in education beyond high school.
