- 3. Ask two <u>university instructors</u> and one other person of your choice who is unrelated to you (high school teacher, headmaster, counselor, minister, employer, supervisor, club sponsor, etc.) to submit a letter of reference on your behalf.
 - ✓ Letters must be submitted <u>on letterhead</u>, contain an <u>original signature</u>, and be submitted via email as a PDF document to <u>honors@hamptonu.edu</u> on or before the application due date.
 - ✓ Subject: Recommendation for *Applicant Name*
- 4. Ask two of your peers/classmates willing to attest to your academic honorability to complete the peer recommendation form on your behalf.
 - ✓ Forms must be submitted via email as a PDF document to honors@hamptonu.edu on or before the application due date, all letter must contain an *original signature*.






